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## SYNOPSIS

The Plough is a constellation. It is also a puppet theatre.

This is the story of a family of puppeteers: siblings Louis, Martha and Lena; their father, who directs the troupe; and the grandmother, who makes the dolls.

Together, they are a company and put on puppet shows. One day, following a performance, the father dies of a stroke, leaving his children alone.



#### DIRECTOR STATEMENT

I wanted to make a film with my three children who have, one after another, become actors for other directors these last few years (I certainly wouldn't have wanted to co-opt them by casting them first). I realize that depicting one's family is a pleasure usually reserved for painters.

Since my children are aged 22, 30 and 38, I had to find a reason to bring them together at those ages.

I decided I would depict a family of puppeteers, several of which still exist, even today. When I was born, before he became an actor, my father was a puppeteer in Gaston Baty's troupe. My godfather, Alain Recoing, also performed in the company.

I wrote the screenplay with Jean-Claude Carrière, Arlette Langmann and Caroline Deruas Peano.

We rehearsed scenes from the film and puppet show every Saturday. Gaston Baty wrote these repertory scenes with Eloi Recoing, one of Alain Recoing's sons. Baty was a member of the "Cartel of Four", along-side Louis Jouvet, Charles Dullin, and Georges Pitoëff, and wrote and performed for his own puppet theater.

When I was a boy, these artists were very poor, but I thought of them as kings. I wanted to make a film that, although born in my imagination, also imitates a documentary on this craft. (Jean-Luc Godard said that a good fiction film must also be a documentary about something). In the disintegration of a company of artist-puppeteers, I see the metaphor of a world where traditions are dying.

#### DIRECTOR BIOGRAPHY

Philippe Garrel was born on April 6th, 1948, and made numerous short films during his youth. In 1967, he directed his first feature film, *Marie pour mémoire*. Three years later, he directed rock icon Nico in the celebrated cult film *La Cicatrice intérieure*. He has directed more than twenty-five feature films, which have screened widely in the most prestigious international festivals. His latest film, *The Plough*, will premiere in competition at the Berlin International Film Festival, 2023.
