SYNOPSIS

Gemma visits Sarajevo with her son, Pietro. 16 years earlier, they escaped the war-torn city while Diego, the boy's father, remained behind and later died. As she tries to repair her difficult relationship with Pietro, she also confronts her past.

Gemma first met and fell in love with Diego in Sarajevo. They desperately wanted children but she could not conceive. Amidst the siege of 1992, they found a possible surrogate, and Gemma pushed her into Diego's arms, only to be overwhelmed by guilt and jealousy.

Now, a revelation awaits her – one that will force her to face the full extent of her loss, the true horror of war and the redemptive power of love.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

This is a fictitious story, created by a writer's imagination and subsequently elaborated into a screenplay for film. The characters, their conflicts, what drives and frustrates them and what they desire, are all fictitious factors. Yet, it's a true story. Because the war in Yugoslavia was so damn real, as was the siege in Sarajevo, the rapes and the memory of all of it which even today, we can read in the eyes of many who lived through those years. The film, or its "make-believe", can't ignore these truths. Thus it's a "real" film, not necessarily realistic, but still, an ethical story, a touching document and a psychological reportage. The journey of the main character, Gemma, who lives through the horrific drama of her missed motherhood and then in the dark belly of war and of the siege in Sarajevo, turns into a journey in search for the most important answer of all: why all this violence? And most importantly, can this violence give birth to light, to a new possibility? This is the answer that we are looking for. It's the "idiotic" utopia of the artist, which we must follow if we don't want to succumb to darkness. The child, who will be born out of that darkness, will have a future with hopes and dreams. And most of all will be better than those who preceeded him.

The adaptation of his wife Margaret Mazzantini's bestseller "NON TI MUOVERE" ("DON'T MOVE") was his second film as director, screenwriter and actor. Shot with Penélope Cruz, in 2004 the film was presented in the *Un Certain Regard* section of the Cannes Film Festival where it met with great international critical success.

MARGARET MAZZANTINI (Author and Screenwriter)

Margaret Mazzantini was born in Dublin and graduated from the Accademia D'Arte Drammatica "Silvio D'Amico" in Rome.

After a precocious and brilliant theatrical career that led her to work with some of the most important Italian and European theatre directors (Aldo Trionfo, Otomar Krejca, Walter Pagliaro, Marco Sciaccaluga, Giancarlo Sbragia), she published her first novel "IL CATINO DI ZINCO" in 1994 and won the *Selezione Campiello* and the *Rapallo Carige* awards.

In 1995, her comedy for two actresses "MANOLA" was directed by husband Sergio Castellitto, and interpreted by herself and Nancy Brilli. A huge public and critical success, the play ran for two years.

In 1998, her second novel "MANOLA" was published by Mondadori.

In 2001, Mondadori published "NON TI MUOVERE" ("DON'T MOVE"). An immediate bestseller, it won the *Strega Award 2003*, the *Grinzane Cavour Prize* and the *Zepter Prize* in Paris. The novel has sold over one and a half million copies to date and has been published in more than 30 countries.

In 2002, Margaret Mazzantini's theatrical monologue "ZORRO" was performed by Sergio Castellitto and published by Mondadori.

In 2004, she worked on the script of **NON TI MUOVERE (DON'T MOVE)**, written and directed by Sergio Castellitto, and starring Penélope Cruz and the director. Number one at the Italian box office, the film won the *Nastro d'Argento* for best script and the *Biglieto d'Oro 2004*. Penélope Cruz was awarded a *David di Donatello* for her performance.

"VENUTO AL MONDO", Mazzantini's third novel, was published in 2008 and won the *Premio Campiello* the following year.
